

FED CAFÉ PRIVACY POLICY

May 2013 – VERSION FOR PILOT PROJECT

What information does the Fed Cafe collect?

We collect information from you when you register on our site, add an Item, post a Comment or reply to a Comment, create a Saved Search, or send a message through the internal email system.

When registering on our site, you may be asked to enter your name, e-mail address, and basic professional or academic information. You may visit our site anonymously but will not be able to utilize it without registering.

What does the Fed Café use your information for?

The information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- To personalize your experience (e.g. to enable your “saved searches” and inbox)
- To improve our website (any feedback we receive from you will help us continually to improve our site)
- To send periodic emails to connect you with other Users or to communicate updates

The email address you provide may be used to respond to your inquiries or requests, and to send you information specifically about website usage or changes.

How do we protect your information?

We implement a variety of industry best-practice security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information when you enter, submit, or access your personal information. Your personal information can be accessed only by you and by site administrators authorized with access rights, who are required to keep the information confidential.

The professional or academic information you disclose in your Fed Cafe profile is viewable by other registered system users.

FedCafe does not collect any sensitive, private information such as credit cards, social security numbers, or financial information.

Do we use cookies?

Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer’s hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enable the site or systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. We use cookies to collect and save your login preferences for future visits.

Do we disclose any information to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information. This does not include trusted third parties who assist us in operating our website, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect our or others’ rights, property, or safety. Neither personally- nor non-personally identifiable visitor information will be provided to other parties for marketing or advertising purposes.

Third party links

This website may link to governmental and non-governmental websites that have separate and independent privacy policies, including those that host documents or media files. We have no responsibility or liability for the content and activities of these linked sites. Nonetheless, we seek to protect the integrity of our site and welcome any feedback about these links.

Additionally, the privacy policies of users’ governmental agency or academic institution are separate and independent.

California Online Privacy Protection Act Compliance

We are in compliance with the California Online Privacy Protection Act. We therefore will not distribute your personal information to outside parties without your consent. As part of the California Online Privacy Protection

Act, all users of our site may make any changes to their information at anytime by logging into their account and editing their profile.

Children's Online Privacy Protection Act Compliance

We are in compliance with the requirements of COPPA (Children's Online Privacy Protection Act); as such, we do not collect any information from anyone under 13 years of age. Our website and services are directed to people who are at least 18 years old.

Online Privacy Policy Only

This online privacy policy applies only to information collected through the Fed Café website and not to information collected or shared offline between users.
